Student and teacher support - overview

The two fields of student and teacher support are combined due to the situation that the teacher support in schools works completely different to universities (the source of the E-xcellence framework).

Students

Student support services are an essential component of e-learning provision and a successful learning of the students. The support must be available in an agreed and published timeframe and cover the pedagogical and technical aspects that affect the online learner.

Support services should be available in the first instance via the student's homepage (like a support forum, accessible for all) or other entry route like email. The support contact must be able to assist in both technical and pedagogical issues.

Teachers

Staff must be supported by the organization as well as by the school authorities. This must cover technical issues as well as the further training and the supervision of teachers.

Hint: The project refers to the European quality benchmark for online, open and flexible education (E-xcellence). The concept is

Checklist for course creation

 $\, \odot \,$ Clear instructions for students exist for the course.

Clear instructions to provide the student support dealing with pedagogical or technical items must be shared with the students.

O Collaborative learning is enabled in the course.
